

Update for Friday, March 27: On Wednesday, March 25<sup>th</sup>, St. Catharines United Mennonite Church's board met via video conference and made the decision that beyond the initial cancellations that had already been made ***all services and weekday activities continue to be suspended until further notice.***

This is in response to continued restrictions relating to Coronavirus / COVID-19.

Along with other churches, we are following recommendations that are being made, in an effort to limit further spread of infection, and protect our most vulnerable of neighbors. The church building will remain closed to all non-essential entry during this time.

Church leadership will continue to monitor the situation, and provide updates, should a decision be made to return to regular activities.
