

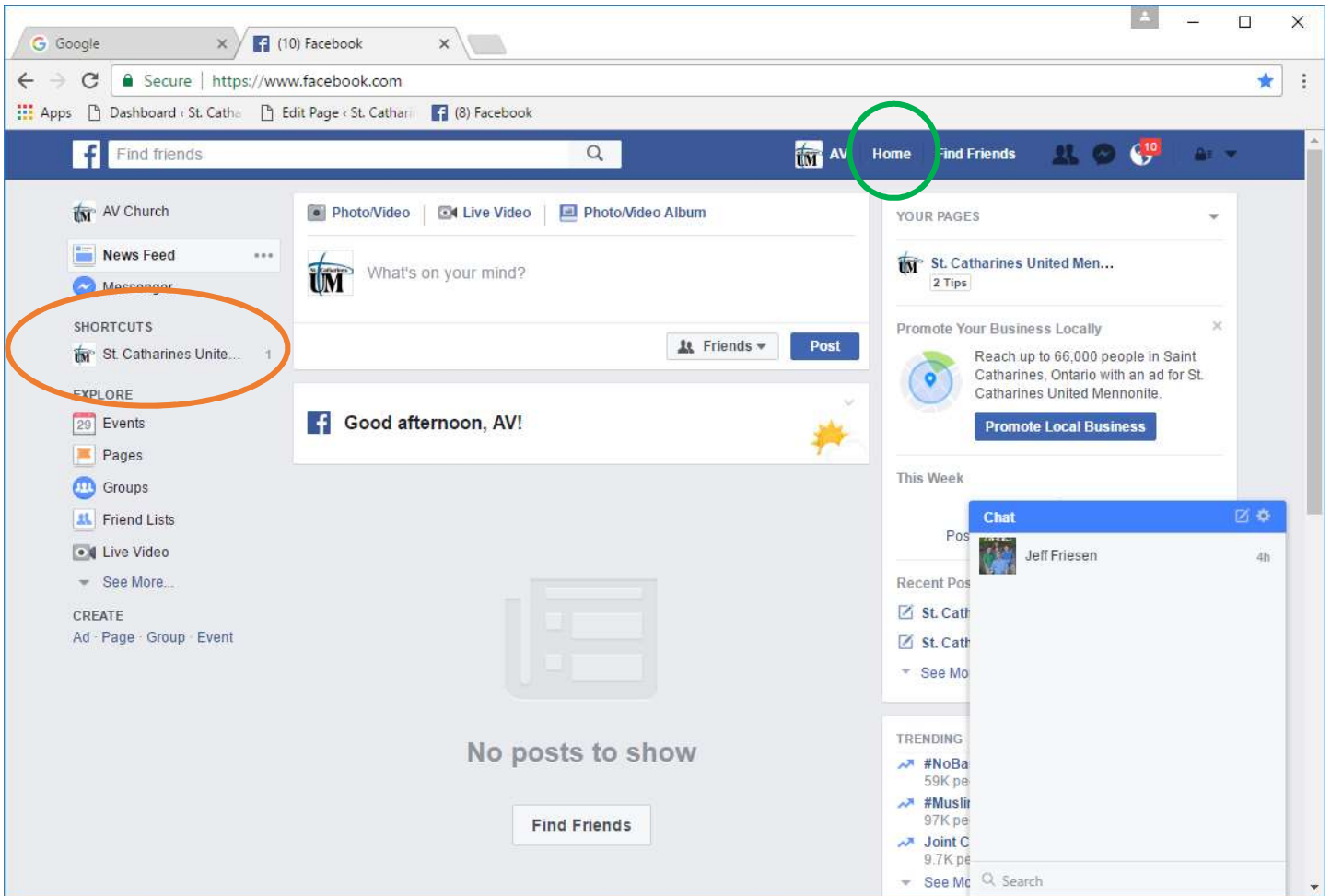
Load OBS studio

If not log in using User: jeffmf21@yahoo.ca Password: ?

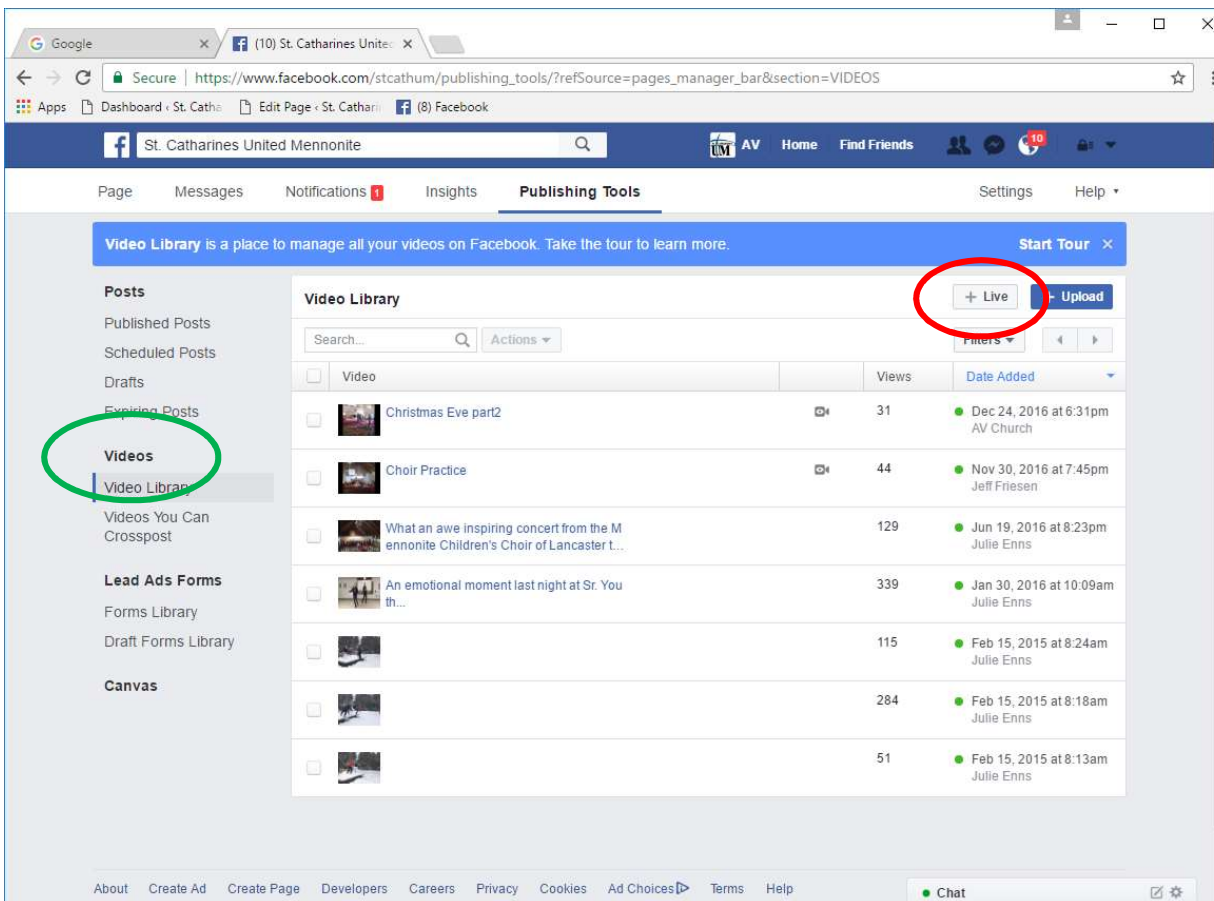
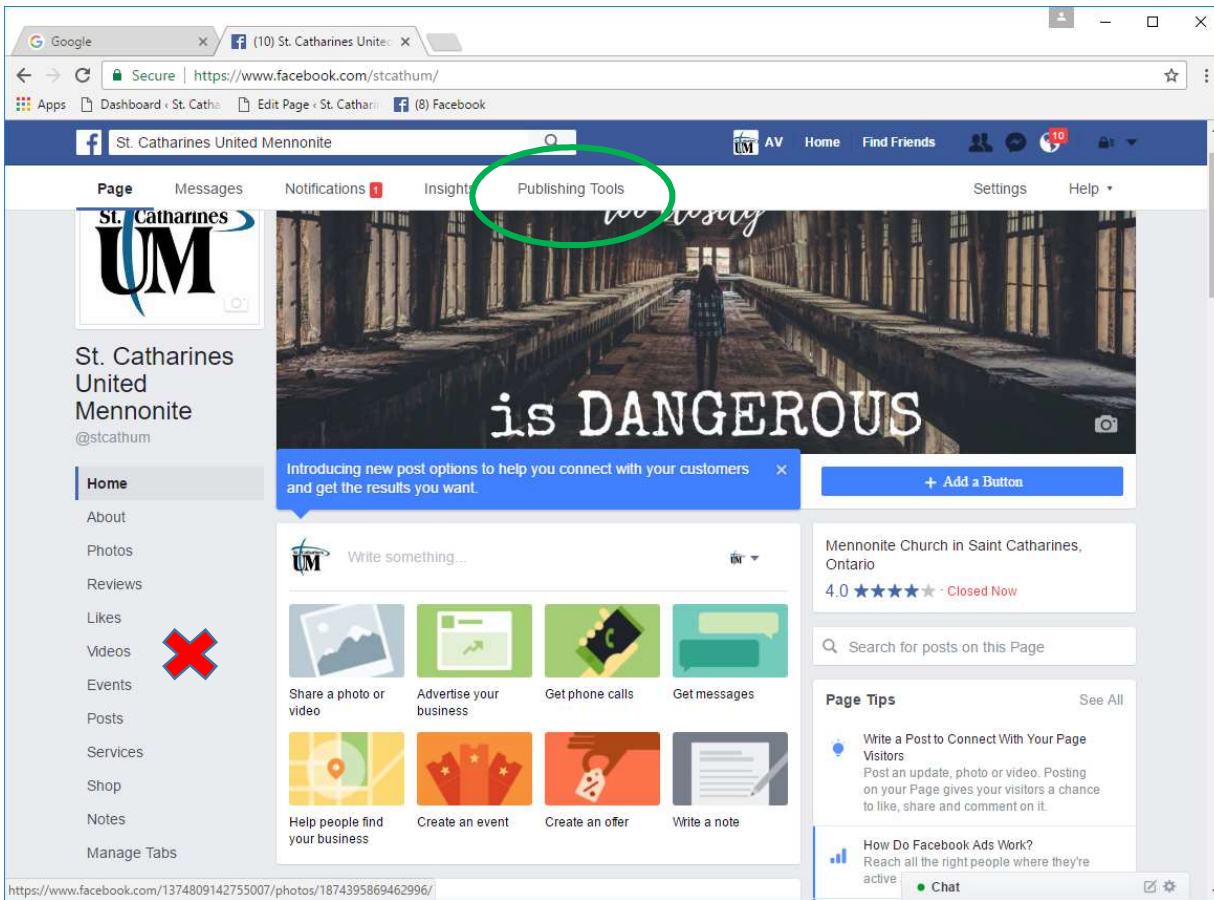

Once logged in click Home from across the top of facebook page circled in green below. This will bring you to the screen as shown below. Click on St Catharines United... circled in orange below. (this will take you to the Church Facebook page)

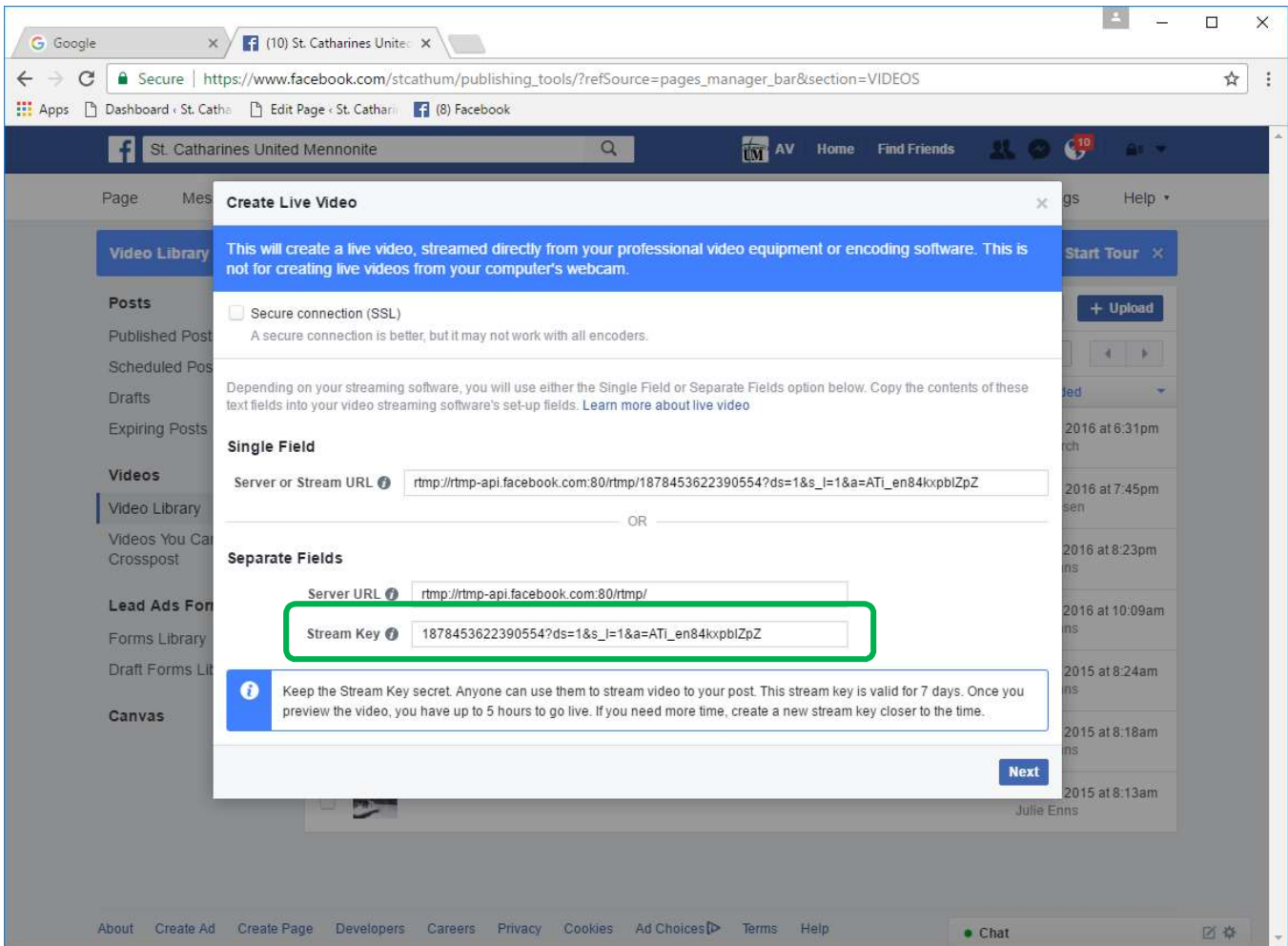


From the Churches Facebook page (see next screen shot, on next page)

Click on Publishing Tools (in green) 1st image, then click on Videos in 2nd image.

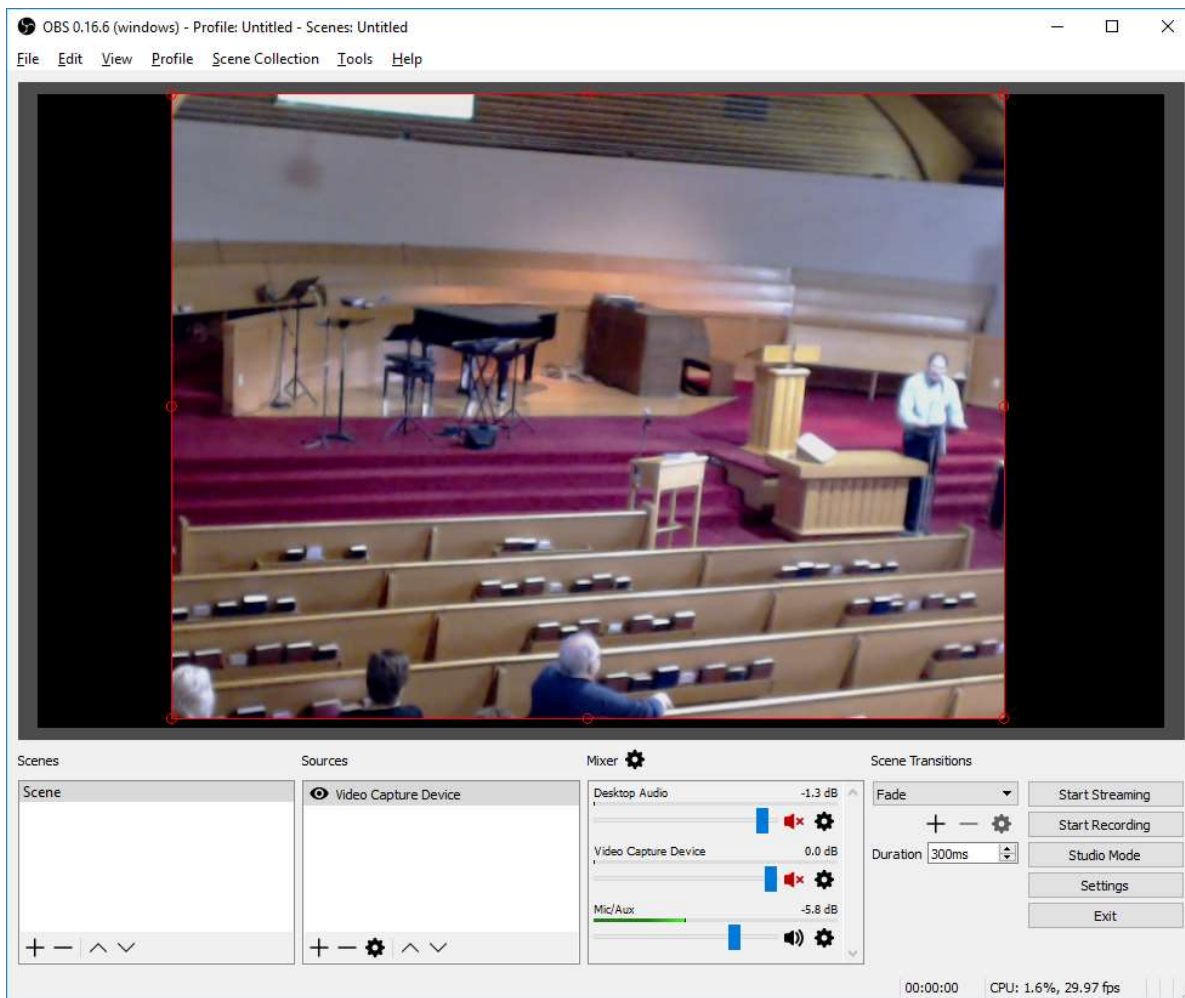


From the above facebook page click +Live circled in red.

Go back to OBS

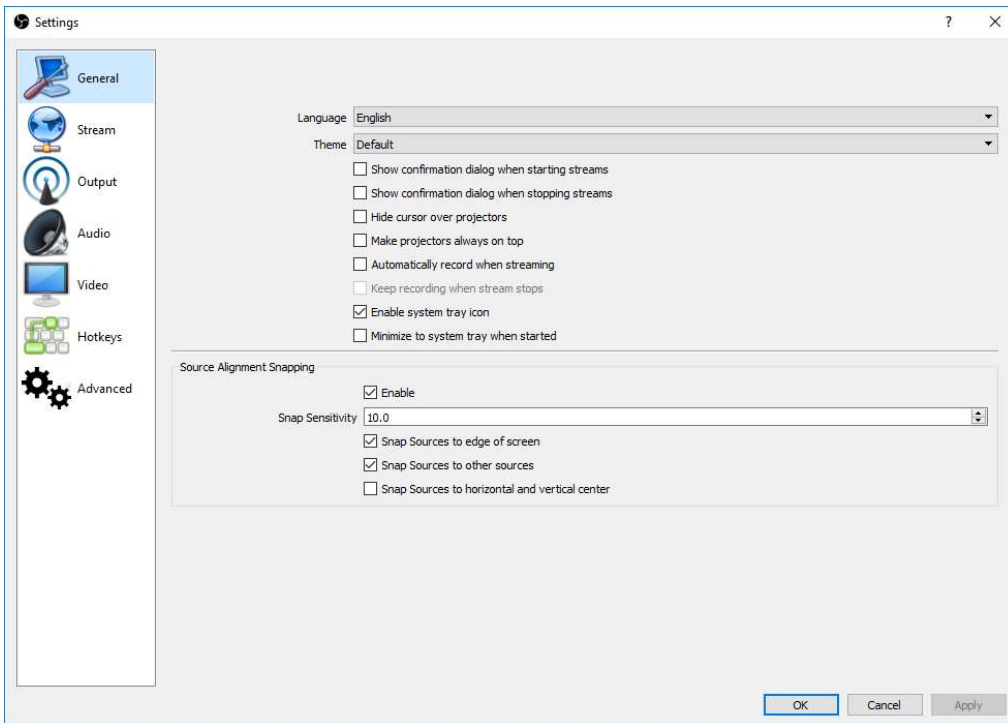


UNDER MIXER (3RD BOX) under image

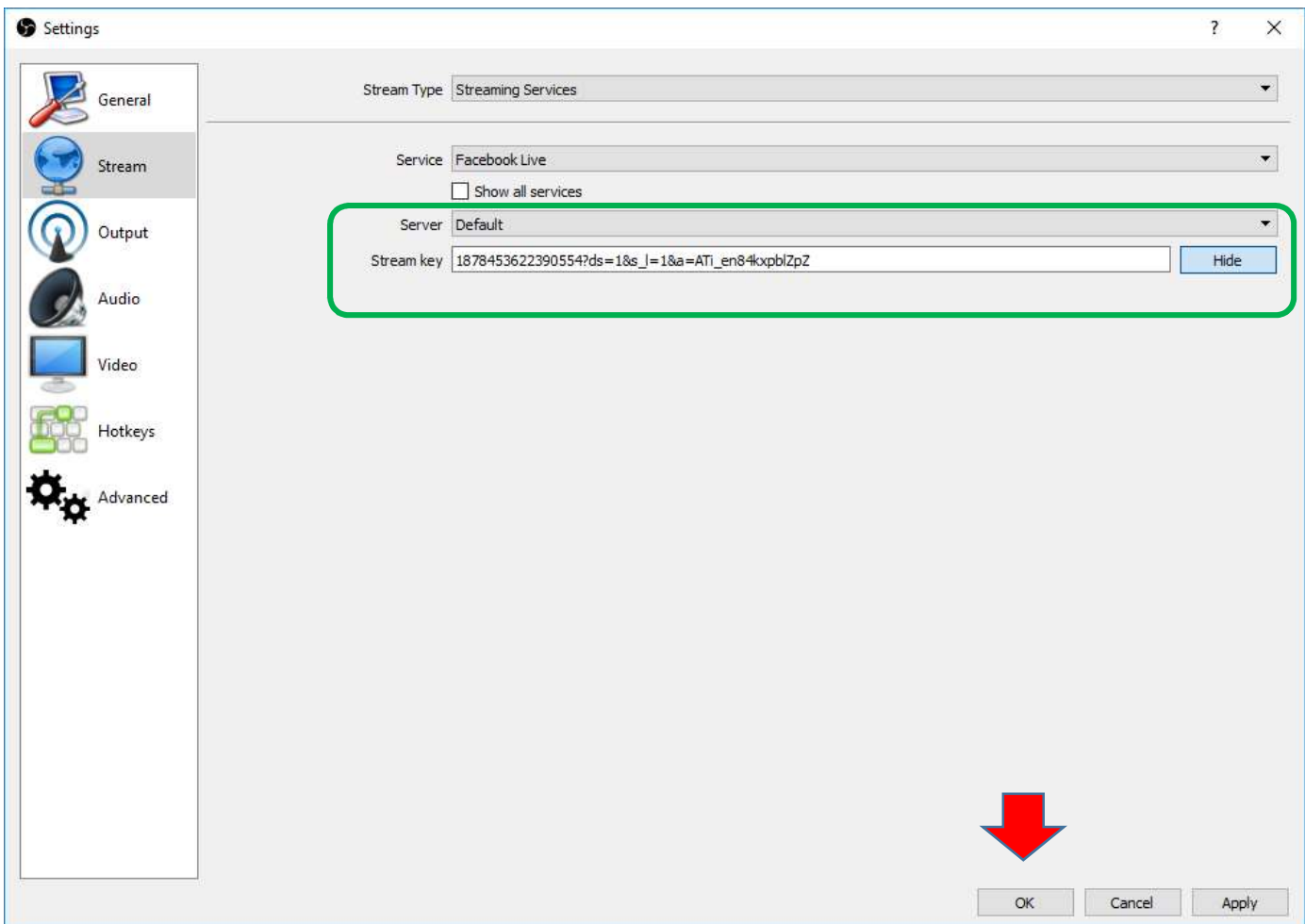
Desktop Audio and Video Capture device should be mute see red X as above. Mic/Aux should be on a green line shows audio level.

To set up streaming proceed to next page

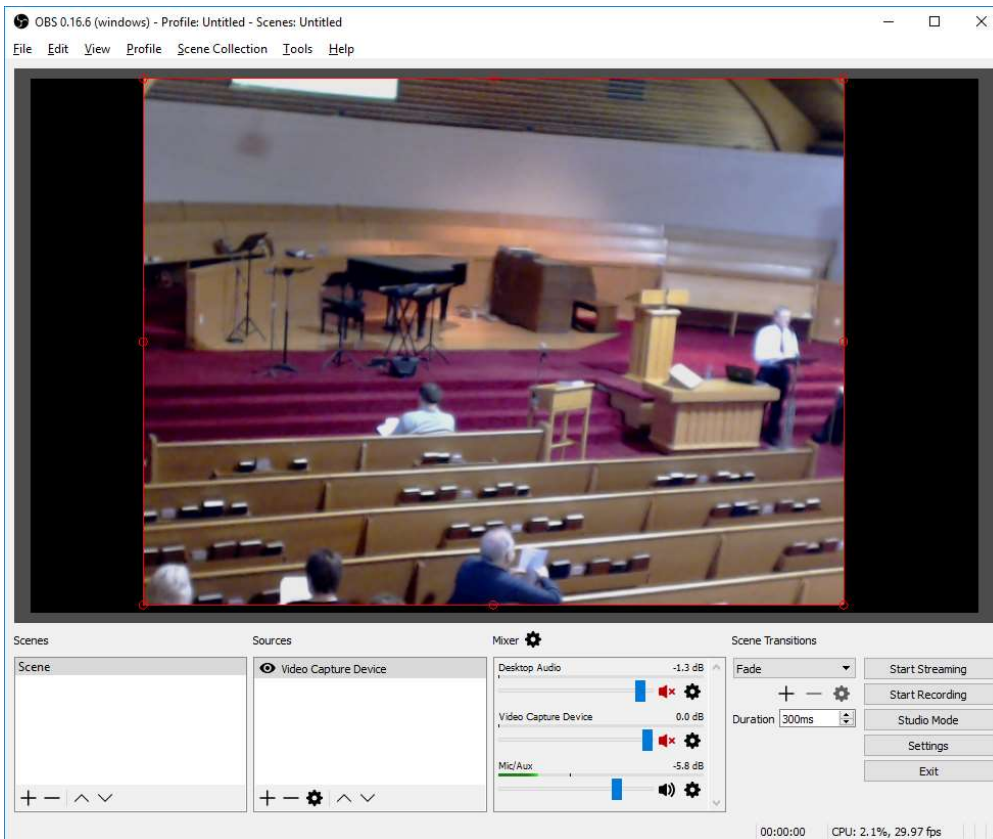
Click on File (pull down menu) choose setting from that menu, this will open the following:



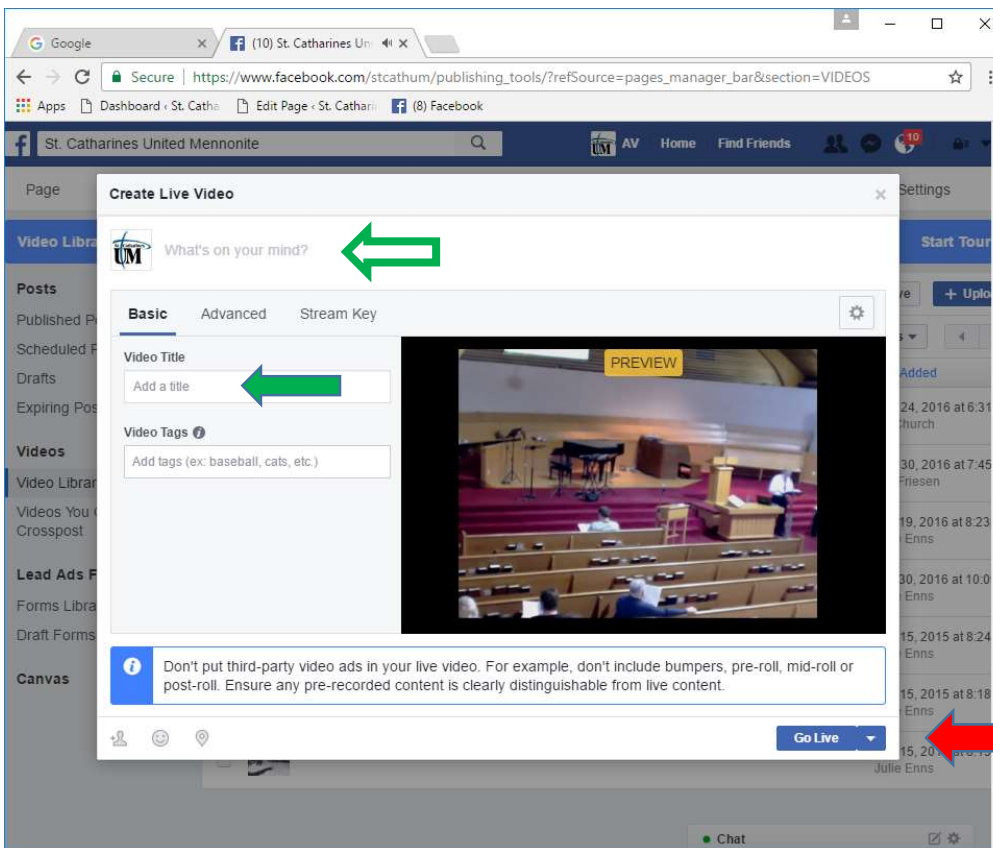
Click on 2nd icon, Stream. Now paste the stream key you copied from facebook and click OK

Facebook will now fetch your video stream from OBS it should look as above, now click Go Live
